
Please Join Us!

Abbot Kinney Triangle Neighbors Association

<u>What</u>: The Abbot Kinney Triangle, <u>bordered by Cabrillo, Grand, and</u> <u>Riviera</u>, is a uniquely affected by Boardwalk and beach conditions, crime, and rapid commercial growth on Abbot Kinney.



- Who: We are a small group of residents of the Abbot Kinney Triangle spearheading this effort. Our immediate goal is to get every neighbor's email address so we can communicate with each other, form an effective neighborhood watch network, and show our numbers when voicing our neighborhood's needs.
- Why: We are spurred to action by the <u>recent and alarming increase in crime</u>, particularly "hot prowls" (break-ins while residents are home).

The <u>success of similar neighbor associations</u> for the Venice Peninsula, the Venice Canals, and the Oxford Triangle suggests that forming our own association will pay dividends in increased public safety and city responsiveness to our concerns.

Plans:

- <u>Compile a comprehensive neighborhood</u> <u>contact list</u> so that we can set various initiatives in motion and keep everybody informed. These contacts will **not be shared** or revealed in mailings.
- 2. <u>Recruit block captains and hold regular</u> <u>neighborhood watch meetings</u> with the LAPD.
- Have larger quarterly neighborhood meetings with city and neighborhood officials and LAPD so we can voice our concerns, pose our requests, and offer our support, on issues ranging from crime to quality-of-life challenges to parking. The first meeting will likely be in early to mid-January 2015
